# CHRIST IS OUR LIGHT

In today's feast we celebrate how on the fortieth day after his birth, Mary and Joseph brought the infant Jesus to the temple. There Simeon proclaimed that Jesus is the "light to enlighten the nations". What he meant is that in a world that is often darkened by sin and suffering Jesus is the one in whom we can place our trust. The Lord shines like a light to show us the way to heaven.

That idea that Jesus is the light of the world, the light who chases away the darkness, is also why the church blesses candles on February 2nd (the traditional name for this day is Candlemas). Whenever we light a candle in the church or at home, we remember that God is with us, that he listens to our prayers and that he brings light, hope and peace even into the most difficult situations.
