#### MASS ATTENDANCE CENSUS

For the third year we have run a count of people attending weekend Masses in our parish for four weekends in February/ March, finishing last weekend. And the good news is that our parish is continuing to grow back from the low-point of the covid period. The average attendance in 2025 is 447, an increase of 5% on last year (425) and 10% on 2023 (405).

Average attendances at the individual Masses across the month were:

Saturday 6pm 153 Sunday 9.30am 142 Sunday 5pm 144

In addition 33 people attended the Dementia Friendly Mass in February. On Ash Wednesday 330 attended Mass here (up 8% on last year).
