#### PRAYER FOR THOSE DOING EXAMS

O great Saint Joseph of Cupertino who, by your prayers, obtained from God to be asked at your examination only the questions that you knew, pray that I, like you, may succeed in the exam which lies before me. In return I promise to make your name known and cause you to be loved. Amen.

## Why is St Joseph of Cupertino the patron saint of those doing exams?

St Joseph was born in Cupertino, Italy in 1603. As a young man he felt a strong calling to the priesthood but was not at all academic. He struggled to learn the theology and was not expected to pass his exams. He turned to prayer and his faith was rewarded. On the day of the exam he was asked the one question he knew the answer to. Another time the examiner passed him without asking him any questions.

He went on to be ordained as a member of the Franciscan Order. Joseph lived a life of great humility and spirituality and had a number of mystical experiences in prayer. He died in 1663 and was canonised in 1767.

> Hail the day that sees him rise, Alleluia! to his throne above the skies; Alleluia! Christ, the Lamb for sinners given, Alleluia! enters now the highest heaven! Alleluia!

Lo! the heaven its Lord receives, Alleluia! yet he loves the earth he leaves; Alleluia! though returning to his throne, Alleluia! still he calls mankind his own. Alleluia!
