DIOCESAN NOVENA TO THE SACRED HEART

The Bishop's novena continues this week until Friday June 7th, the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Their are several ways to pray the novena. The simplest is to say the following five short prayers every day for the nine days:

- I believe in God, I hope in God, I love God.
- I am sorry for having offended God.
- · Sacred Heart of Jesus I believe in your love for me.
- Sacred Heart of Jesus I believe you love me now.
- Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in thee.

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, for whom it is impossible not to have compassion on the afflicted, have pity on us miserable sinners and grant us the grace which we ask of you, through the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, your tender Mother and ours.

You can pray the longer version of the novena in the prayer booklet that was given out at Mass last weekend, The prayers are also available to pray online through Facebook each day and they will be prayed together at Masses in our family of parishes.

On Tuesday Mass is available at 10am in St Malachy's, Coleraine and 7pm in Portstewart.

On Thursday Mass is available at 9.30am in Portstewart and 10am in Coleraine.


FEAST OF THE SACRED HEART
