The Church has now returned to the season of Ordinary Time. From now until the end of November we will count down the weeks of the year. In our readings we go back to the teachings of Jesus to learn from him about the kingdom of heaven.

This Sunday we go back to the beginning and the story of Adam and Eve and the first sin. This story (more of a parable really) explains how human weakness and outside temptation push us into disobeying God. And that sin grows and grows until the whole world is hurting. Jesus came into the world to save us from sin. He teaches us how to follow God. He shows us how God's love is greater than any force. And he died to save us. Because of that he forgives us our sins when we approach him with trust. May we always seek forgiveness and reconciliation with the Lord.
