JESUS FEEDS HIS PEOPLE

For most of this year the Gospel readings at our Sunday Masses come from St Mark. But over the summer, beginning this week, we hear Chapter Six of St John's Gospel where Jesus explains the Eucharist to his followers.

It begins this week with the miracle of the feeding of the five thousand. Jesus knows his followers are hungry and he wants to feed them. So he takes bread and fish and miraculously feeds the great crowd. It's a powerful moment, but the Lord will go on to explain that God has something greater in mind. In the coming weeks we will hear Jesus tell us how he wants to feed all his people with his own flesh and blood. That is the miracle of the Eucharist which we share in every time we come to Mass.

WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR GRANDPARENTS

The World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly is held on the fourth Sunday of July each year. This Sunday was chosen because it falls near the feast of Ss. Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus on 26th July. This year the day is marked on 28th July.

Pope Francis has granted a **plenary indulgence** to anyone who visits a sick, lonely, or disabled elderly person on 28th July. Those who are sick and housebound may gain the indulgence by praying for this intention and uniting themselves spiritually to the rest of the Church.

The plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions that we:

- Reject sin.
- Go to **Mass** and receive **Holy Communion**.
- Go to **Confession** (within three weeks either side of Sunday).
- **Pray** for the Pope's intentions (an Our Father and Hail Mary would suffice).
