STOP COMPLAINING AND COME TO ME!

In the Gospel today Jesus continues to tell his listeners that he is the Bread of Life come down from heaven. But they're not impressed! The crowd like Jesus when he carries out miracles but when he speaks about God and heaven and the Eucharist they lose interest and start complaining.

The Lord's answer is simple - stop complaining and come to him with faith. And that advice is for us too. We need to come to Jesus with faith and trust if we are to receive his gifts. And first and foremost that means coming to Mass on Sundays and holy days where Jesus gives us the Bread of Life in Holy Communion. This week includes the feast of the Assumption on Thursday, a holy day of obligation. Let's make sure we come to Mass with faith and devotion.
