



## THE REAL PRESENCE OF IESUS

This Sunday we continue our exploration of the Eucharist by focusing on the Real Presence of Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus insists that his flesh is true food and his blood true drink, a teaching that many found difficult to accept. Yet, this belief in Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist has been central to Catholic faith since the earliest days of the Church.

The Real Presence isn't just a theory, but a reality that should transform how we approach our faith. It should influence our behaviour in church, how we receive Communion, and how we live our daily lives. We're invited to deepen our relationship with Christ in the Eucharist every time we come to a church where the Lord is waiting to bless us with his grace.

#### ARCHBISHOP NOEL TREANOR

We were deeply sorry to hear of the death of Archbishop Noel Treanor in Brussels last Sunday. Archbishop Treanor was Bishop of Down & Connor from 2008 to 2022 when he was appointed Apostolic Nuncio to the European Union by Pope Francis.

During his time as our bishop, Archbishop Treanor made many pastoral visits to Ballymoney particularly to celebrate confirmation and to rededicate Our Lady & St Patrick's church after renovations in 2012. Archbishop Noel also ordained Fr Damian to the priesthood in 2011 in St Malachy's, Coleraine.

The Archbishop's funeral takes place in St Peter's Cathedral in Belfast on Tuesday at 12noon. It can be watched online. We pray for the repose of his soul and offer his family and friends our condolences. May he rest in peace. Amen.
