# THE LAW OF LOVE

In the first reading this week we hear how important the Law was to the Jews. God's great law written in the scriptures was the most important gift that the Jews had received from the Lord. And keeping it faithfully was their most solemn duty.

But over the centuries the law was filled out, extended, clarified and specified so that keeping it it completely became a huge task which required the skill of a lawyer. That's why

Jesus offers his teaching here - that's God's law should be honoured and obeyed, but that what really matters is what is in a person's heart. We can commit many sins privately that never break a law! But if we love with all our hearts then we need never fear any legal judgement.
