In today's Gospel Jesus is trying to teach his followers about sacrificing yourself for others, as he soon will on the cross. But his friends aren't listening. Instead they are squabbling about who is the most important of them.

So Jesus tries another way of teaching them. He calls over a child and tells the disciples to be more childlike and to welcome others in the same way. For us, that means taking ourselves a little less seriously and being more open to God's love. We should have a special care for those in need because they are the children of God. And we should remember that God loves us as his dear sons and daughters too.
