THE CHALLENGE JESUS GIVES US

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus challenges a rich young man to sell all he has and follow him. It's a huge thing to ask, and the man turns sorrowfully away. This prompts us to consider God's unique plan for each of our lives. While we may not be called to give up everything, God does ask us to face challenges that help us grow in faith and become more like Christ.

We might feel daunted, like the rich young man, but Jesus reassures us with his love and promises abundant blessings. THANKS FROM THE RNLI


