On this Gaudete Sunday, we're invited to pause amid the Christmas preparations and reflect on what truly matters. The Gospel shows people asking John the Baptist, "What must we do before the Lord comes?" It's a good question for us too, and the answer is not about what we need to buy or organise.

This Sunday reminds us that Christmas isn't just about external preparations, but about welcoming Christ into our lives. John the Baptist's message is simple yet profound: be generous, be honest, and be compassionate where you are. God doesn't want dutiful servants, but loving children who rejoice in his presence. This week, take time to listen, to hope, and to embrace the true spirit of Advent. Christ is coming - not to judge, but to save and fill our hearts with joy.

HOLY YEAR 2025

On Christmas Eve Pope Francis will open the Holy Door in St Peter's in Rome to begin the Jubilee Holy Year of 2025. A jubilee is traditionally celebrated by the Church every twenty five years. It is a year set aside for us to repent of our sins and forgive the sins of others, and to renew a focus on our spiritual life.

In the Diocese the celebration of the Holy Year will begin the following Sunday on the Feast of the Holy Family. All parishioners are warmly invited to join Bishop Alan McGuckian at the Solemn Opening Mass on Sunday 29th December at 3pm in St Peter's Cathedral, Belfast. In Ballymoney we will mark the beginning of the Holy Year and our own Parish Bicentenary year with Mass and Benediction at 10am on New Year's Day.
